#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING A GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT

- 1. Complete the form below and attach the following documentation:
  - a. A map of the area intended to be explored
  - b. A copy of the certificate of fining of the geophysical exploration bond filed with the Montana Secretary of State
- 2. Contact the Department of Revenue (406-765-2291) before filing the application.
- 3. Provide the \$5.00 filing fee to the Clerk and Recorder.
- 82-1-105. Exploration permit. (1) Upon compliance with the provisions of this section, namely the filing of a notice of intention to engage in the exploration and a certificate or a copy of the certificate from the secretary of state certifying the name and address of the resident agent for service of process for the person, firm, or corporation desiring to engage in the exploration and certifying that the required surety bond has been filed with the secretary of state, the county clerk and recorder shall issue to the person, firm, or corporation a geophysical exploration permit.
  - (2) The permit must show:
  - (a) the name of the person, firm, or corporation and the principal place of business;
  - (b) if a firm or corporation, the names and addresses of its officers;
- (c) the name and address of the resident agent for service of process for the person, firm, or corporation;
  - (d) that a notice of intention to engage in geophysical exploration has been filed; and
- (e) that a good and sufficient surety bond has been filed by the person, firm, or corporation, naming the surety company and giving its address.
- (3) The permit must be signed by the county clerk and recorder or the clerk and recorder's deputy and bear the official county seal. The permit is valid and effective for all geophysical crews of the permittee during the calendar year in which it is issued.
- (4) The cost of the permit is \$5 per calendar year or any portion of the calendar year for which issued, and the revenue realized from the permit must go to the county issuing the permit. The funds must be applied toward payment of the cost of printing the permits, which must be printed at the county seat, and excesses must be deposited in the county's general fund.
- (5) If printed forms are not available at the time any person, firm, or corporation desires the permit and qualifies for its issuance, a typewritten or other form of reproduction of the permit may be used, the fee of \$5 must still be paid for its issuance, and this fee must be disposed of in the same manner.
- (6) The permit or a copy of the permit must be carried by the person or by the agent of the firm or corporation at all times during the period of the geophysical exploration and must be exhibited upon demand of any county or state official.

# INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING A GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION WORK COMPLETION FORM-MCA 82-1-108

- 1. Within 3 months from the day that seismic firing is done, a seismographic company needs to file a record showing each township and range where the work was performed and approximate date.
- 2. We have a form to use with the documentation for the filing of the completion record.
- 3. Although Montana Code (below) is not specific about the form that the record should take, we suggest that a map showing the location of the surveyed shot points and dates be submitted. In our experience, companies often prefer to do that up front in case a problem comes up with a landowner.
- 82-1-108. Filing record of work performed. (1) Within 3 months from the day that any firing of shotpoints in seismic exploration is done by a person, firm, or corporation within this state, the person, firm, or corporation shall file with the county clerk and recorder of the county in which the work was done a record showing each township and range within the county in which the work was performed and the approximate date on which the work was performed.
- (2) The person, firm, or corporation shall file with the county clerk and recorder a record showing the location of each shotpoint and date fired within a maximum area of any square, 4-section area of land, upon written request of the county clerk and recorder. The request must be based upon the complaint of a property owner that physical damage to the owner's property has resulted from the use of the seismograph and explosives in seismic operations at some location within the maximum 4-square mile area, and the request must designate the name and address of the complaining person and the approximate date and nature of the alleged damages. The required record of operations in response to the request of the county clerk and recorder must be supplied within 30 days from the date on which the request is received.

### ATTENTION SEISMOGRAPH COMPANIES

Personal Property, including equipment used for seismic exploration that is brought into Sheridan County at any time during the year is subject to taxation from the time the equipment enters the state of Montana until the end of that year according to Montana Code Annotated 15-24-301. This equipment must be reported to the Sheridan County Department of Revenue Office here at the courthouse before seismic exploration commences.
